July 27 Primary Election Candidate Surveys

Candidates Surveyed on Right-to-Life Issue

We sent questionnaires about pro-life legislation to candidates in the July 27 Primary Election. The questions and responses from congressional candidates appear immediately below, followed by a different set of questions, and the responses of candidates for Oklahoma statewide offices and the Oklahoma state legislature.

Federal Candidate Survey

In anticipation of the Primary Election on Tuesday, July 27, Oklahomans For Life and National Right to Life asked the twelve questions below of candidates for the U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senate. The initial after candidate's name represents party affiliation (<u>Republican</u>, <u>Democrat</u>, or <u>Independent</u>). On the first eleven questions, a <u>"yes" answer</u> <u>indicates agreement with the position of Oklahomans For Life</u>. On question 12, the answer "A," "B," or "C" is shown, as indicated by the candidate.

1) In its 1973 rulings in *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton*, the U.S. Supreme Court created a "right to abortion" for any reason until "viability" and for any "health" reasons – including "emotional" health – even during the final three months of pregnancy. Do you support the reversal of the *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton* decisions, so that elected legislative bodies may once again protect unborn children by limiting or prohibiting abortion?

2) There is now overwhelming scientific evidence that abortion methods used by the fifth month (and perhaps earlier) such as the "dilation and evacuation" (dismemberment) method, and the partial-birth abortion method, cause excruciating pain to the unborn child. Would you support legislation to strictly limit abortion at least from the point in development that evidence suggests an unborn child has the capacity to experience pain?

3) Many women who undergo abortions later regret that they were not given full information about their unborn child beforehand. Would you support federal legislation, such as the Ultrasound Informed Consent Act, to require that before an abortion is performed, the abortionist must perform an ultrasound and display the ultrasound images for the mother, so that she may view the images? 4) The right to life of human beings must be respected at every stage of their biological development. Human individuals who are at the embryonic stage of development should not be used for harmful or lethal medical experimentation. This applies equally to human beings whether their lives were begun by *in vitro* fertilization, by somatic cell nuclear transfer (human cloning), or by some other laboratory technique. We oppose harvesting "stem cells" from living human embryos, since this kills the embryos. (We are <u>not</u> opposed to other research on stem cells that are obtained without killing embryos, *e.g.*, stem cells harvested from umbilical cord blood and from adult tissue. Will you vote for measures to protect living human embryos from being used for medical experiments that would harm or kill them, including so-called embryonic stem cell research that would require the killing of human embryos, regardless of the method used to create these human embryos?

5) Would you vote to renew the current Hyde Amendment policy (restricting federal Medicaid funding of abortions) without weakening amendments?

6) Longstanding federal law prohibits performance of abortions at U.S. military facilities, even if privately funded (except to save the life of the mother, or in cases of rape or incest). Would you vote against any attempt to weaken or repeal this pro-life policy?

7) On February 26, 2008, in legislation to reauthorize all federally funded Indian health programs, the U.S. Senate adopted an amendment to permanently prohibit these programs from providing abortions, except to prevent the death of the mother, or in cases of rape and incest. However, that bill died without action in the House. Would you vote for legislation to permanently prohibit the providing of elective abortions in federally funded Indian health programs?

8) Under Presidents Reagan, George H.W. Bush, and George W. Bush, executive orders collectively referred to as the "Mexico City Policy" established that in order to be eligible for U.S. population-control funds, a private overseas organization must agree not to perform abortions (except to save the life of the mother, or in cases of rape or incest) or to "actively promote abortion as a method of family planning." However, in January 2009, President Obama overturned this pro-life policy by executive order. Would you support legislation to reinstate the Mexico City Policy, and would you oppose any legislation that would prohibit a future president from reinstating the policy by executive order?

9) Would you vote for the Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act (which prohibits the circumventing of state parental-notification or consent laws by making it a federal offense to transport a minor across state lines for a secret abortion) and would you oppose weakening amendments?

10) Title X ("Title 10") of the Public Health Service Act provides more than \$300 million annually for grants to state and private entities for "family planning" programs. Although federal law does not permit such funds to be used directly to pay for abortions, large amounts of Title X funding go to organizations, *e.g.*, Planned Parenthood, that operate abortion clinics. Would you support legislation to make organizations that operate abortion clinics ineligible for Title X funding?

11) From its inception, the pro-life movement has been as dedicated to protecting people with disabilities and older people from euthanasia as it has been to protecting unborn children from abortion. Some hospitals have

implemented formal policies authorizing denial of lifesaving medical treatment against the will of a patient or the patient's family if an ethics committee thinks the patient's so-called "quality of life" is unacceptable, even though the patient and family disagree. The federal Patient Self-Determination Act currently requires health care facilities receiving Medicare or Medicaid to ask patients on admission whether they have an advance directive indicating their desire to receive or refuse lifesaving treatment under certain circumstances. Would you vote to prevent involuntary denial of lifesaving medical treatment by amending the Patient's or surrogate's choice for lifesaving treatment would be likely, in reasonable medical judgment, to result in or hasten the patient's death, a health care provider unwilling to respect the choice for lifesaving treatment must allow the patient to be transferred to a willing provider and must provide the treatment pending treatment pending treatment would pend the treatment pending treatment would be the patient.

12) The National Right to Life Committee (NRLC) believes that unborn children should be protected by law, and that abortion should be permitted only when necessary to prevent the death of the mother. Under what circumstances, if any, do you believe that abortion should be legal?

A – Only to prevent the death of the mother (the NRLC position).

B – To prevent the mother's death, in cases of incest committed against a minor, and in reported cases of forcible rape. C – Other

State Candidate Survey

In anticipation of the Primary Election on Tuesday, July 27, Oklahomans For Life asked the twelve questions below of candidates in Oklahoma statewide races and in races for the Oklahoma state Senate and the Oklahoma state House of Representatives. <u>The most important question is No. 1</u>, and the candidate's answer to that question is written in capital letters. (We asked Statewide candidates, who could not literally "vote for" these measures, to indicate whether they "support" them.) For House and Senate races, the counties or partial counties (marked by an asterisk) in the district are indicated after the district number. The initial after a candidate's name represents party affiliation (Republican, Democrat, or Independent). On each question, <u>a "yes" answer indicates agreement with the position of Oklahomans For Life</u>.

1) Upon reversal of the U.S. Supreme Court's *Roe v. Wade* decision, will you vote for a law that would protect the lives of unborn children and prohibit abortion except to prevent the death of the mother?

2) If efforts to enact such a law failed, will you vote for a law that would prohibit abortion except when necessary to prevent the death of the mother, or when the pregnancy is the result of forcible rape (reported to law enforcement authorities within seven days), or when the pregnancy resulted from an act of incest committed against a minor (with the perpetrator reported to law enforcement authorities)?

3) Medical research demonstrates that an unborn child, at least by 20 weeks after fertilization, has pain receptors throughout his body that are linked by nerves to the brain's thalamus and sub-cortical plate. We also know that these unborn children seek to evade noxious stimuli and that certain stress hormones dramatically increase in response to those stimuli – the same type of hormone increases that, in a child or adult capable of saying, "It hurts," have been associated with pain. Would you support legislation to strictly limit abortion at least from the point in development that evidence suggests an unborn child has the capacity to experience pain?

4) The 2010 federal health care law, known as the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, allows states to opt out of using tax-dollars to provide abortion coverage in the state-based insurance "exchanges" it creates. Would you support legislation which allows our state to prohibit all qualified health plans offered through the state Exchange from including abortion coverage, except to prevent the death of the mother?

5) If efforts to enact such a law failed, will you vote for a law that would prohibit all qualified health plans offered through the state Exchange from including abortion coverage except when necessary to prevent the mother's death, or when the pregnancy is the result of forcible rape (reported to law enforcement authorities within seven days), or when the pregnancy resulted from an act of incest committed against a minor (with the perpetrator reported to law enforcement authorities)?

6) Would you oppose the establishing or funding of school-based "health" clinics, unless they are explicitly prohibited from doing abortion counseling or making abortion referrals or referring students to any other entity which counsels for, refers for, or performs abortions?

7) Recently, there have been attempts in several states to pass a state Equal Rights Amendment which would amend the state Constitution to invalidate any law or government policy that discriminates "on account of sex." In some of the states that have already added this or similar provisions to their state constitutions, courts have used them to invalidate limits on abortion. The New Mexico Supreme Court, *e.g.*, in 1998 unanimously ruled that the New Mexico ERA required state funding of abortion. We oppose the ERA unless an "abortion neutralization" amendment is added to ensure that the ERA will not change abortion policy in any way. The amendment would read: "Nothing in this article [the ERA] shall be construed to grant, secure, or deny any right relating to abortion or the funding thereof." Would you vote against any proposed ERA if it does not contain this "abortion neutralization" amendment?

8) The right to life of human beings must be respected at every stage of their biological development. Nevertheless, some have proposed taking living human embryos from *in vitro* fertilization clinics and harvesting their stem cells, thereby killing these embryonic human beings. While we support research on stem cells obtained without killing human embryos – *e.g.*, stem cells harvested from umbilical-cord blood or from adult tissue – we oppose killing embryonic human beings. Would you vote for a law to protect living

human embryos from being used for medical experiments that harm or kill them, including so-called "embryonic stem-cell research" that would require the killing of human embryos?

9) There is currently an aggressive drive underway to legalize euthanasia and assisted suicide across the United States. Causing the starvation or dehydration deaths of persons with disabilities and of incompetent patients who are deemed to be a burden on others or to have a diminished "quality of life" is the euthanasia movement's interim goal while they seek eventual public acceptance of killing by lethal injection or by lethal overdose of controlled substances/dangerous drugs. Oklahoma's Hydration and Nutrition for Incompetent Patients Act protects incompetent persons who have not directed that they be deprived of food and water so they will not be victims of death by starvation or dehydration. Will you oppose any attempt to repeal or weaken this protective law?

10) Oklahoma law protects against the involuntary denial of life-saving medical treatment by requiring that if a health-care provider's refusal to comply with a decision made by or on behalf of a patient to receive life-saving medical treatment would, in reasonable medical judgment, be likely to result in the patient's death, then the health-care provider must provide the life-saving treatment pending transfer of the patient to a willing provider. Will you oppose any attempt to repeal or weaken this protective law?

11) Will you oppose the legalization of lethal prescriptions or lethal injections to intentionally kill an innocent person or to "assist" someone in committing suicide ("active euthanasia")?

12) Oklahoma's advance directive (living will) law recognizes the particular importance of food and water. In order to ensure truly informed consent, our law requires a separately-initialed paragraph in an advance directive in order for artificial administration of food and water to be rejected. Some proposals have been made that would, instead, combine food and water with "medical treatment" such as respirators or surgery, so that choosing to forego life-sustaining medical treatment would be assumed to mean the individual wanted to die by starvation and dehydration. In order to avoid confusion and protect individuals who expect to die from their underlying illness or injury, not from starvation or dehydration, will you vote against any bill that would repeal or weaken the existing requirement for a separately-initialed provision in an advance directive to indicate the rejection of food and water?
